## Set up

- 1. Crate a folder for the project
- 2. Unzip UniCurses-1.2.zip
- 3. Copy unicurses.py to the folder
- 4. If you are not no windows skip to 7
- 5. Unzip pdc34dll.zip
- 6. Copy pdcurses.dll to the folder
- 7. Done

## Testing

- 1. Do the same as Set up by for the demos folder
- 2. If you are not no windows skip to 5
- 3. Open Python 3.4.3 (command line)
- 4. Skip to 6
- 5. Open a console.
- 6. Change directory to the demos folder
- 7. Type python test\_background.py
- 8. Hit enter
